COVID-19 has required everyone to rethink how education can be taught and delivered. This session will cover new initiatives from RIDE's Office of College and Career Readiness to better support middle schools and high schools during this unprecedented time. The All Course Network is designed to help districts and schools meet this need by creating opportunities for Rhode Island students to envision, pursue and realize their individualized graduation pathway outside of the traditional school day, by providing opportunities through dual enrollment, career credential, work-based learning, AP, and enrichment courses. Sub-Group #3: Early Warning System (EWS) 2.0

RIDE has created an Early Warning System (EWS) in collaboration with The Policy Lab at Brown University and DataSpark, a tool designed to help administrators and teachers identify 6th – 12th grade students who are at risk of not graduating from high school. Using a series of indicators, the dashboard provides color-coded risk “bands” to inform a multi-tiered system of support and keep students in school and on track to graduate.
